## **Hearing Screening**

On May 2nd, Grant Wood Area Education Agency (GWAEA) will be screening all students in Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades. Students with IEPs will also be screened. Students in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, junior high, and high school who are new to the school that don't have a documented hearing screening on file will be screened as well. Some students with a history of known hearing loss will also be tested. Follow-up testing may occur periodically if previous hearing test results were not within normal limits. Parents/guardians not wishing to have their student tested should notify Denise Jorgensen in the office in writing before **April 22**.

## **☀️ 📄 Summer Review Workbooks**

The school year is quickly coming to a close, and the summer months are rapidly approaching. Summer is a great chance for students to enjoy a break from schoolwork. However, statistics show that students can lose up to two months of scholastic skills over the summer if they do not spend any time reviewing what they have learned. They are designed for each of the various grade levels (Kindergarten – 6<sup>th</sup> grades). The child completes one page a day (both sides) for five days a week during the summer months. This should not take more than 20 minutes a day. There are 50 pages in the workbook – one page for 5 days a week over a 10 week period. The workbooks are produced by BJU Press, the same company that publishes some of the material we use here throughout the school year. This allows for consistency in the presentation of the material. The answers to the exercises are provided for parents, so you can check your child's work. Sample copies of the workbooks can be viewed in the office. Each workbook costs \$18.00. All orders are due by **May 10**.

**If you haven't started using the Scrip program yet, or would like to know more about it, it is not too late! Those who purchased gift cards or online codes through Scrip December to March will see their tuition/fee credits this month.** Scrip is "substitute money" in the form of gift cards, which you purchase in advance of your shopping, and then pay for your purchases with the gift cards or online codes, just as you would with cash/credit card. You can use Scrip cards to purchase everyday expenses like food, gas, clothing and other essentials. **With every purchase, you earn tuition/fee credits as well as additional funds that support the school. Staff, parents, extended family and high school students can purchase Scrip in person, online, or on the go!**
