The last bulk restock order of scrip physical cards before break will be submitted at 4:00 p.m. today. You will still be able to purchase from what we have in stock during the short week before Christmas break. You may submit your order online through Isaac Newton's school website under the Parent Info link – we will contact you when your order is ready to pick up in the office. With your personal ShopWithScrip account, you can choose to receive ScripNow electronic codes instantly while shopping and skip the delay of paying by cash/check when signing up for PrestoPay, which can be linked directly to your bank account. Cumulative Records

The LCEA Board of Directors requires the administration of Isaac Newton Christian Academy to establish and maintain a system of student records. This system is compliant with the "Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974" (FERPA) and other applicable laws and regulations. All student records are confidential. Access to a student's individual cumulative record is restricted to the parents or legal guardians, Head of School, Administrative Assistant or designee, and faculty. The Head of School may grant access to others with recognized facilitator and consultant roles, such as Grant Wood AEA staff. All other access shall be compliant with FERPA and other applicable laws and regulations.

Our student records are secured in an on-site fireproof safe. The school also has a secure back-up file of each student record that is stored electronically off-site. Federal legislation prohibits the school from releasing information – oral or written – about a student to any individual or agency without written consent of the parents or guardians. There are more policies that pertain to student records and access to the information in student records. You can read more about that in our Student Handbook.
