- Our faculty started the school year with a prayer walk through the halls and classrooms at Isaac Newton Christian Academy, praying the students and staff?
 Over the last six years, Isaac Newton Christian
- Over the last six years, Isaac Newton Christian Academy high school students have raised over \$20,000 for their senior class trips? They participate in the Avenue of Flags program to help raise the funds. Students place a 3' x 5' American flag attached to a 10 ft. pole in the front of subscriber's homes on the five "flag holidays" (Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, and Veterans Day). Subscribers have a metal sleeve in their yard. On the flag holiday, the student slides an American flag into that sleeve and takes it down at night. A typical flag route has 40 flags on it. Through a local service club, our students are paid \$4.00 per flag.
